CO. CORK B. P. & P. ASSOCIATION COLLEGE AND HIGH SCHOOLSCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

RULES AND REGULATIONS AWARDS -The awards will consist of scholarships ranging between \$1,000 - \$2,500. Awards may be used for tuition only and will be paid directly to the college or accredited institute of higher knowledge at which the awardee is accepted. High school scholarships will range between \$600-\$800.

JUDGING - The judges will be selected annually by the Scholarship Committee. They will be comprised of scholars and leaders in the community who are not members of the Association. The decision of the judges will be final. The decision will be made, judged on style, organization, and content.

ELIGIBILITY - The Scholarships are open to members in good standing as of November 1, 2023, and to the children of members in good standing graduating high school in 2024.

College applicants must have completed high school and must submit SAT scores for 2023 and an essay to qualify for a scholarship.

High school applicants must be in 8th grade or entering high school.

DISQUALIFICATION - Entrants must comply with all the rules regarding the scholarship competition or be subject to disqualification. Disqualification will be made only by the majority vote of the Scholarship Committee and will be final and binding. Any information supplied by entrants found to be untrue will result in disqualification.

ESSAY RULES - The subject of the essay will be: **High School, Margaret Buckley- and College, General Tom Barry,** the essay must be at least 1,000 words and must be typewritten and double spaced on 8-1/2 x 11 paper. The title must be placed at the top of the paper. Entrant's name or any other identifying marks will not appear on the essay paper. A bibliography of sources for the essay material must be attached to the essay. Each essay must be the sole work of the entrant. All essays received become the property of the Association and may be printed in the future using the contestant's name.

APPLICATION - Fully completed application forms and a copy of the applicant's SAT scores must accompany all essays. All applications must be sent by U.S. mail to Kathy McCarthy, 10 Lenox Road, Apt. 2-H, Rockville Centre, NY. 11570, or by email to **mcleen16@aol.com**, and must be received no later than midnight, January 2, 2024.
